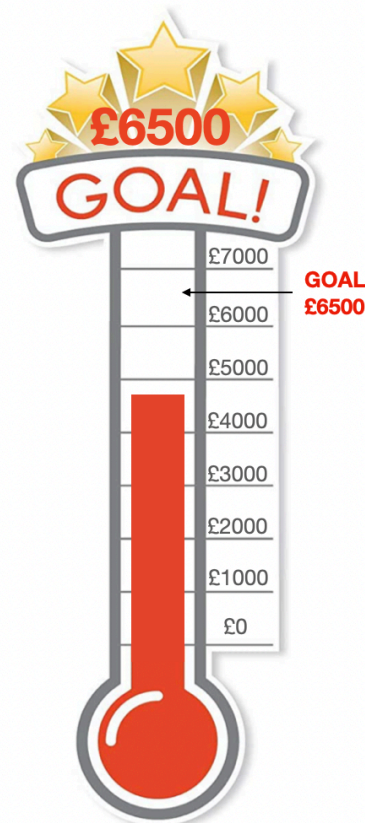
## THANK YOU!
