Parent Consultations—4th and 7th December








Great Work

What motivation to learn!





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
Parents of Styal Christmas Fair

Remembrance Day **Donations**


Thank you to everyone who bought Remembrance Day items. We raised a whopping £202.05. Thank you so much for your generosity.

























Styal Primary School Valuing the Individual to Believe and Achieve
