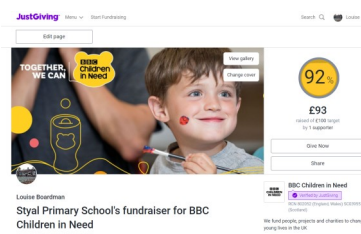


Children in Need—Thank You

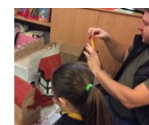

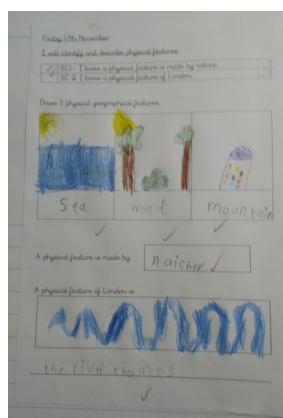
Mr Smith's PE Award
