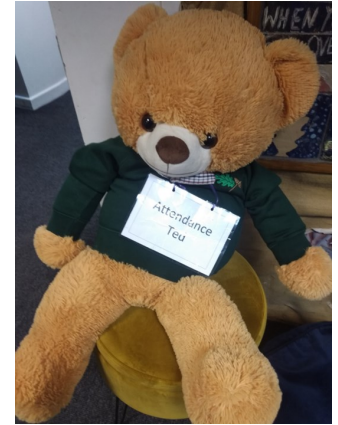

POS would like to say a huge thankyou to all who supported the event with donations, helping on the stalls and setting up on the day.

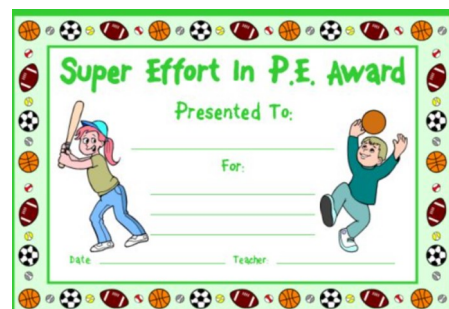
POS are well on their way to their £6,000 target.

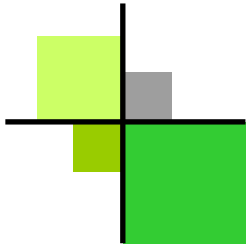

Well done to you both.





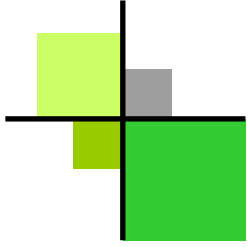

On Monday this week, the children in KS2 performed some carols and classic Christmas songs to their families.

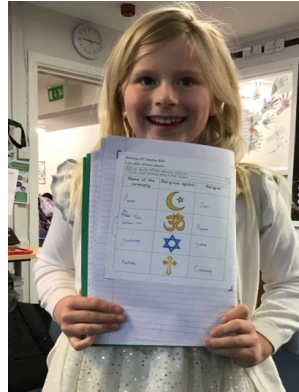
Len the minister at Norcliffe sent a lovely message thanking the children for bringing such joy to the chapel with their singing.



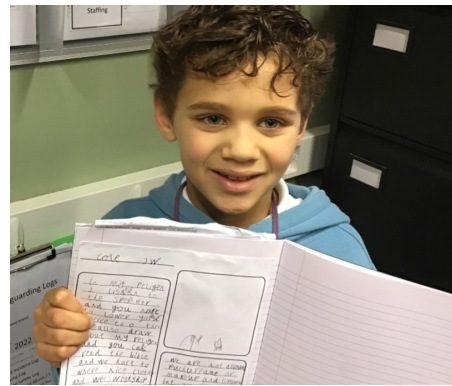

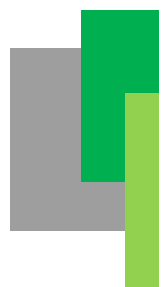

We welcome the children supporting such causes at Styal.

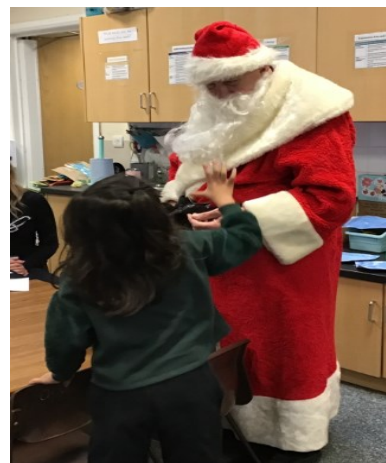

He was able to drop in to all the classes to say hello and answer some questions before dashing off to his workshop to get ready for Christmas.





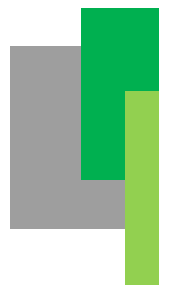

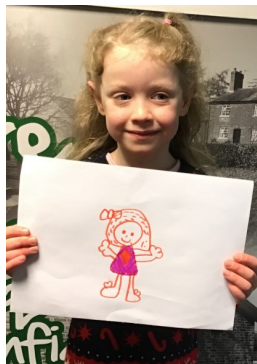
