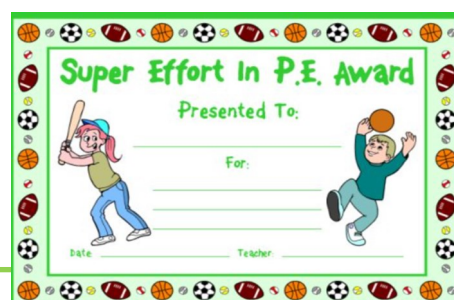

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Walk to School Week

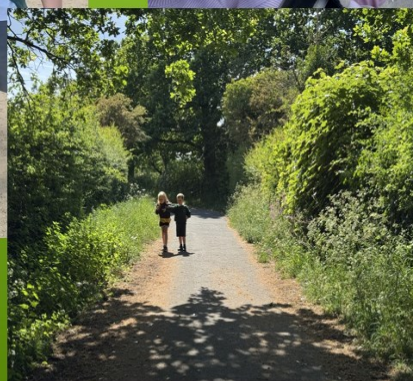
A big thank you to all our families who have taken advantage of the beautiful weather this week and have taken part in our Walk to School week initiative.

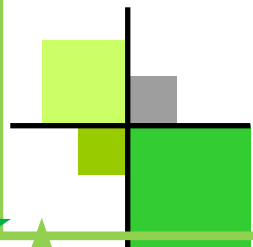

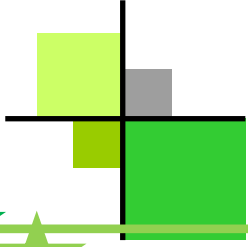
Message from Mrs Gaulton

This week we made that happen, as our whole school made class visits to the Chapel on Wednesday for Interfaith Day.

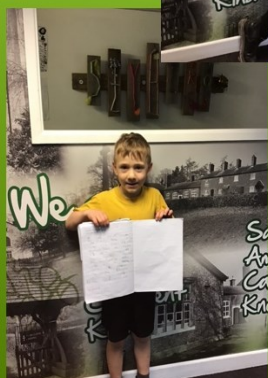
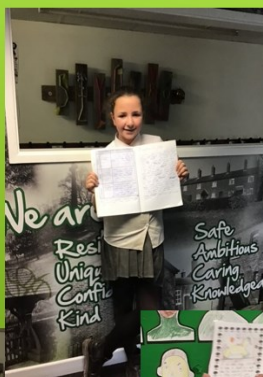
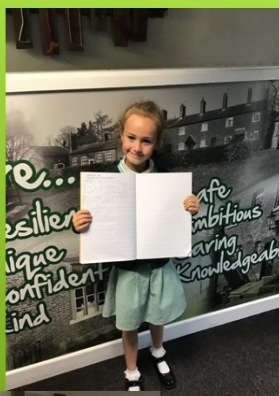
We were honoured to attend and the children were a credit to school and we hope would have made Len very proud.
