The children were thrilled to show off their talents in Art with some beautiful pictures created from natural resources collected in Forest Schools.


We had Rainforest themed board games, yoga and puzzles too.

Thank you to our Y3/4 team for organising an enjoyable morning for everyone.



#### Mr Smith's PE Awards



#### **Message from Mrs Gaulton**


Welcome back to school everyone! We hope you all had a lovely half-term break and managed to have some fun - despite the lack of sunshine that we had become used to!


