Mobile phones are **not allowed** in school. However, in certain circumstances we appreciate that Year 5 / 6 children may need to carry a phone, particularly if they are walking home without an adult.

Therefore, we are asking parents to think carefully about sending mobiles into school and we ask that paperwork is returned if a phone will be needed by your child.

Styal Primary School Agreement

Styal will provide a locked place for phones to be stored in Upper Key Stage 2. Children must take responsibility for collecting their phone at the end of the day. If forgotten they will remain in the locked place until the next day.

Styal Primary School take no responsibility for returning the mobile phone to the pupil or the safety/security of the phone.
